When they first boarded the ship, Turkish police wanted to come on board for inspection, but the French captain refused to let them on. Harry and Krikor hid on the ship until it was on its way. Krikor had an uncle who worked in a grocery-meat store in NY. This is where they stayed while they looked for jobs. Before moving to Milford MA, he worked in a shoe factory in Farmington MA. He moved to Milford MA in 1900 and worked in several grocery stores. He eventually purchased his own grocery store. He worked there for 50 years. Eventually his son, Harry Jr. sold it and it burned in 1970-71. He set Yesia up with a fruit stand business in Woonsocket RI, but it only lasted one

year (1908-09).
